Q1 a Hard Start, but a *great outlook*

This project was undertaken as a QTN initiative sponsored by the Queensland Government and with the assistance of QMI.

As part of the review it was pointed out that we need to do a lot more to promote **Hi-tech**

Tooling; as part of this we have prepared a long term marketing plan, so look forward to a new website early 2010 and a number of other promotional activities.

We are planning a Winter Break for anyone interested. This will be along the lines of the Intensive Training Weekends that were very successful in 2001 and 2002. At this stage this will be a weekend mid July with a Bush destination. If you are interested please drop us a line; there will be a open fire cook off with a celebrity judge. For anyone from interstate we will arrange transport from the airport.

As mentioned earlier there have been a number of developments that are part of our ongoing development, these are mentioned later in more detail. But very briefly, we have been awarded the Tooling Maintenance Contract for the MRTT Project based in Brisbane. The first REA Race Track has been shipped to the UK and we have been able to extend our products and services in the Pharmaceutical Tooling area. For *Hi-tech* Tooling each of these represent significant progress with our ongoing development and we look forward to reporting our progress in each area.
